Responsibilities: The Shady Grove Director will be responsible for the day to day operations of the site. Duties will include but are not limited to teaching HRM courses (the number of courses to be determined by the Department Chairman); advising students; developing and implementing a location marketing plan to include participation in career and transfer day activities at local community colleges and high schools in Montgomery and surrounding counties; and maintaining contacts with local community colleges and assisting in the development of articulation agreements. Performs other related duties as assigned.

Qualifications: Master's degree required. Ph.D. preferred. Five years of hospitality industry and higher education experience required. Preference will be given to candidates with knowledge of the hospitality industry in the Montgomery County area. Ability to get along with others required. Note: Individuals with degrees outside of the US may be subject to verification at the expense of the candidate.
