**Responsibilities:** This is a teaching-intensive position (12 credit hours per semester) with opportunities for research reductions after the first academic year. Research

productivity is important but secondary to teaching excellence and a strong commitment to student engagement. Division faculty are expected to participate in academic advisement, student mentoring, and other student engagement activities as required by the Chair and/or Dean.

**Qualifications:** Ideal candidates will possess a doctorate in Hospitality Management and have experience teaching undergraduate Hospitality Management courses as the instructor of record. Preferred area of expertise are Hospitality Accounting/Finance, Event Management, or Lodging. Industry experience and knowledge of the New York City hospitality industry preferred but not required.

Candidates should be familiar with technology-supported learning pedagogy and be able to integrate technology into teaching. Candidates must exhibit potential for research productivity and professional growth.
