Supervises the Operational Manager of La Chanterelle to ensure that the service program remains integral to the academic curriculum. Teaches up to two courses each semester; serves on Deans Council. Performs other duties as required to meet the goals of the school and the College. Qualifications include Doctorate in hospitality and/or hotel management preferred; management experience in the hospitality and hotel industry, preferably both nationally and globally; college level teaching and administrative/supervisory experience; strong leadership and motivational skills; innovative and entrepreneurial in approach to new initiatives and challenges; collaborative management style.
