Minimum Qualifications: Assistant Professor: Doctorate from a college or university of recognized standing in a relevant field. Evidence of teaching ability at the baccalaureate level; evidence of ability to publish research in refereed academic journals; poise and good address for meeting and conferring with others. ABD candidates must submit a letter from their committee chair confirming their expected date of completion. Associate Professor: In addition to the minimum qualification required for assistant professor, a minimum of two years of full-time college or university teaching at the rank of associate professor or equivalent; a research and service record commensurate to appointment at the rank of associate professor.

Desirable Qualifications: Assistant and Associate Professor: Record of funded research and/or experience related to the travel industry; experience with web-enhanced and/or distance education. Associate Professor: a strong service record (e.g., serve as board member in professional organizations or academic journals).
