Summary: The Assistant Professor at the Florham Campus, International School of Hospitality and Tourism Management (ISHTM) reports to the Director of the International School of Hospitality and Tourism Management, and Dean of Petrocelli College. The primary teaching responsibilities consist of graduate and undergraduate courses in hospitality and tourism management. The School offers two bachelor's degrees, two master's degrees and a combination BS/MS degree. This is a tenure-track position that requires teaching 12 credit hours of graduate and/or undergraduate coursework per semester, or 24 credits in an academic school year.
