A doctorate in a business or hospitality discipline is required; ABDs are considered if degree will be completed before the start of employment. A minimum of five years of hospitality industry work experience in a supervisory or managerial capacity is required. The salary and benefits package is competitive and commensurate with qualifications for an AACSB accredited business school. Qualifications for this position include [1] a strong commitment to teaching excellence, [2] a demonstrated research potential, [3] the capability to collaborate with faculty and industry stakeholders, and [4] having the desire, skill, and ability to successfully teach larger, introductory courses in hospitality and tourism.
