TENURE TRACK ASSISTANT/ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR

The School of Sport, Tourism and Hospitality Management (STHM) is soliciting applicants for a tenure-track assistant/associate professor in the Tourism and Hospitality Management Department. Applicants will be expected to conduct quality research as well as teach undergraduate and advanced graduate courses in the following strategic management areas: **entrepreneurship, organizational behavior, cost control, feasibility analysis and/or multi-unit/asset management**. The rank and salary will be based on qualifications and experience. Ph.D. in tourism and hospitality management or a related field is required. The appointment begins fall 2019.

The faculty member will be expected to develop an active research program that is consistent with the broad areas of focus within the School. Preference will be given to applicants who have a strong publication record, an established record in sponsored research projects, and teaching experience in both graduate and undergraduate academic programs. Experience with online education (course development or teaching) is a plus.

Temple University is a large urban university located approximately 2 miles north of Center City Philadelphia, the heart of the local tourism industry, making it ideal for teaching and learning experiences for STHM faculty and students. The Tourism and Hospitality Program has a strong reputation for student placement that is a result of quality educational experiences supported by required internship experiences across all three degree programs: Bachelor of Science in Tourism and Hospitality Management, Master of Science in Hospitality Management and Master of Science in Travel and Tourism. The School of Sport, Tourism and Hospitality Management is a self-standing school, affiliated with Temple University's Fox School of Business and Management, where a Ph.D. in Business Administration with a Tourism and Sport emphasis is offered.
