

The Hart School of Hospitality, Sport and Recreation Management at James Madison University invites applications **for a lecturer in Hospitality Management**. The position is a renewable term appointment beginning in the fall 2019. Candidates must be able to be on campus for a start date of mid-August 2019. The position is a full time position in Harrisonburg, Virginia and is benefits eligible.

Primary responsibilities involve teaching courses in the Hospitality Management Program in lodging and club management. This position has a four/four teaching load during the regular academic year and class sizes typically range from 30 to 50 students. Additional teaching opportunities and specific assignments are dependent upon departmental needs.

Required qualifications include a master's degree in hospitality or a related field, at least one degree in Hospitality Management, at least three years of teaching hospitality classes at the collegiate level and/or professional management work experience in the club and/or lodging industry.
